The observations for the Review Period are identical to those of previous year's namely Financial Year 2018-19.

The Listed Entity appointed Independent Women Director during the Review Period. However, the number of non-executive directors continued to be less than 50% of the total strength of the Board of Directors. Also the total number of independent directors was less than half of the total number of Directors on the Board. The Listed Entity renewed its request to exonerate it from paying the penalty levied. The Listed Entity being a Central Public Sector Undertaking and in pursuance to its Articles of Association has requested the Government of India to fill up the vacancies of Independent Directors to be compliant with the provisions of Regulations 17(1)(a) and 17(1)(b) of LODR) Regulations, 2015.
